## LOGGING ON

- Go to [www.ellis.thomson.com](http://www.ellis.thomson.com) and click OJ OnlinePlus from the log in box.
- Enter your Username and Password.

## HOMEPAGE

From the **Search All** screen you can search directly for all EU materials .

Links to access content search screens.

Links to extensive help files and the log off button.

The EU Web Directory is a portal to thousands of searchable, EU related web pages.

## CONTENT

OJ OnlinePlus is based on EUR-Lex (the official database of the EU) with ELLIS Publications’ enhancements plus a wide range of background and press information **collected daily** from Curia, Prelex and Rapid. OJ OnlinePlus contains:

- Treaties and International Agreements
- Official Journal L & C records fully indexed, cross-referenced and updated daily
- National measures implementing EU directives from all member states
- Case law - all cases before the ECJ and CFI updated on a daily basis
- Consolidated legislation
- Preparatory documents - Commission proposals, legislative resolutions, opinions, Council common positions
- Commission decisions - from prior notification to published decision collected daily from the website of the Competition Commission
- EFTA documents - judgments, agreements from the EFTA institutions
- Press releases, public register documents, agendas, minutes and other publications from the principle EU bodies
- EU Web Directory – a collection of nearly 2000 searchable EU websites

## BASIC SEARCH


**Search All** can be used across all material types. Type your search term or phrase in the search boxes provided.

*Free text* searches for your term in the whole document. Use *Words in title* to restrict your search to the title.

Select a content specific search form from the left-hand menu for focused searching. These forms contain relevant search fields to assist searching a particular type of content, e.g.. case law.

Quick links to Advanced search, Nicknames, Treaties.

## SEARCH FIELDS

EU documents are identified in general by document number, type, publication reference and date.

Search forms contain relevant fields for the content type and contain helpful examples. They are linked by the boolean operator AND. In **Advanced search** forms there is an option to switch operators to OR / NOT from the pull down menu.

## SEARCH METHODS

- OJ OnlinePlus supports phrase searching so it searches for terms next to each other and in the order they are entered onto the search form, e.g. **hazardous waste**.
- Connectors AND/OR/NOT can be used to refine searching, e.g. **transport and hazardous waste**.
- Use the connector WITH to find documents that contain words in the same paragraph but not necessarily next to each other, e.g. **water with pollution**.
- To search for a phrase containing a boolean operator you must place the operator between quotes, e.g. **health "and" safety regulations**.
- Proximity searching allows you to search for a search term within a set number of words from another term, e.g. **water.3.pollution**.
- You can use wildcards (\*/? ) to substitute a character or characters in a string, e.g. **bank\*** (for banks, banking, banker), **organi?ation** (for organization or organisation).
- You can drag and drop or copy and paste your search terms in the search forms.



## BASIC SEARCH

Select **Official Journal** from the left-hand menu. This form has useful search fields to quickly find documents published in the *Official Journal L and C Series of the European Union*.

You can restrict your search to legislation by ticking the *Official Journal L Series* tick box. The *Official Journal C Series* contains information, preparatory acts and notices. You can also specify the type of document you require, e.g.: directive.

Open Nicknames to find legislation by its familiar name.

THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community, and in particular Article 71 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Economic and Social Committee <sup>(1)</sup>,

Having consulted the Committee of the Regions,

Acting in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 251 of the Treaty <sup>(2)</sup>,

Whereas:

(1) Council Directive 96/96/EC of 20 December 1996 on the approximation of the laws of the Member States relating to roadworthiness tests for motor vehicles and their trailers <sup>(3)</sup> has been substantially amended several times <sup>(4)</sup>. Since further amendments are to be made, it should be recast in the interests of clarity.

(2) Within the framework of the common transport policy, certain road traffic within the Community should operate under the most favourable circumstances as regards both safety and competitive conditions applying to carriers in the Member States.

(3) The growth of road traffic and the resultant increase in danger and nuisances present all Member States with safety problems of a similar nature and seriousness.

## BASIC SEARCH

Select **Case law** from the left-hand menu. This form has useful search fields to quickly find case law documents.

Parties search field can be used to find all cases relating to a company. You can restrict your search by adding a date or type of document, e.g. judgment.

Link to **Advanced search** to use a form with a wider range of search fields.

## DOCUMENT VIEW

The full text contains keywords, document references and links to related information.

You can jump to highlighted search terms within the text and you can change the view from the pull down menu to browse full analytical information of the case.

## BASIC SEARCH

Select **Background information** from the left-hand menu. This form has useful search fields to quickly find documents published by the major EU Institutions and Agencies made available through Rapid, Europa's Press Room.

Documents include agendas, memos, speeches, reports, minutes and a wide range of publications. To retrieve **Press information** tick the appropriate box.

Use **log off** to exit OJOnlinePlus otherwise your session will remain active until the 30-minute automatic log off.

## NEWS SOURCES

The EU Web Directory contains a collection of nearly 2000 EU websites which can be searched and browsed.

To find additional EU news sources click the appropriate box in the search form. A list of publications will be displayed which will link directly to the website.

- You can select which display format you require, e.g. Text.
- Click the send, save or print button.
